**Whether, in regard to the sugar sector reform, he will state –**

- (a) the details of the agreement reached between Government and the Mauritius Sugar Producers Association;**
- (b) how disbursement of the European Union accompanying funds is now expected to evolve;**
- (c) when the St Félix workers will receive their Blueprint benefits; and**
- (d) if he has been made aware of the recent report made by Mr Paul Goodison, Director of the European Research Office and Adviser to Ms Glenys Kinnock, on sugar industry of the African Carribean Pacific countries, including Mauritius?**
