I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Nandcoomar Bodha, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to *the Honourable Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Finance & Economic Development* at the sitting to be held today, **Thursday 21 June 2007 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Honourable Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Finance & Economic Development:-

Whether, in regard to the measures announced in the Budget 2007-2008, in relation to subsidy policy, inflation and price of commodities, he will state -

- (a) the estimated rate of inflation for the financial year 2007/2008;**
- (b) if Government proposes to change its policy regarding price of commodities under maximum mark up and price control; and**
- (c) the estimated number of beneficiaries of income support and subsidy on the School Certificate and Higher School Certificate Examinations fees?**
