I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Nandcoomar Bodha, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to *Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence & Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service & Administrative Reforms, Minister of Rodrigues & Outer Islands* at the sitting to be held today, **Friday 29 June 2007 at 3.30 p.m.**

*To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence & Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service & Administrative Reforms, Minister of Rodrigues & Outer Islands :-*

**Whether, in regard to law and order, he will state –**

- (a) the figures, as from January 2007 to date, relating to alleged cases of –**
  - (i) murder, manslaughter and assault;**
  - (ii) police brutality;**
  - (iii) hold up;**
  - (iv) larceny of scrap metal and other metallic items;**
  - (v) larceny with violence where women and the elderly are victims;**
  - (vi) offences against tourists;**
  - (vii) drug related offences and offences dealing with pornographic material, indicating the respective number of cases in which minors are involved; and**
- (b) if any new pattern of criminal behaviour has been noted and, if so, the measures taken to combat same?**
