**Private Notice Question**

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Nandcoomar Bodha MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Acting Prime Minister at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 18 July 2006 at 11.30 a.m.**

*To ask Dr the Honourable Acting Prime Minister:-*

**Whether, in regard to the Police operation carried out in the vicinity of Pétrin, Grand Bassin on or about Friday 07 July 2006, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, the following information –**

- (a) the names of the persons arrested and the objects seized;**
- (b) if these persons are allegedly involved in recent hold-ups and other serious offences;**
- (c) the names of other persons, if any, arrested in relation thereto; and**
- (d) if an inquiry is being carried out and, if so, where matters stand?**
