**Whether, in regard to the issues of violence against and sexual abuse of children and, in particular, following the alleged cases of rape and murder of A. J<sup>1</sup>. in July 2005 and A. J. A<sup>2</sup>. in June 2006 and the alleged case of torture and murder of A. B<sup>3</sup>. in July 2006, she will state –**

- (a) if her Ministry has carried out an inquiry thereinto and the outcome thereof; and**
- (b) the measures taken by her Ministry to address the above issues?**
