Whether, in regard to the taxation measures regarding income announced in the 2006-2007 Budget Speech, he will state –

- (a) Government policy in regard to income derived in the form of (i) interest and (ii) other benefits; and**
- (b) the changes proposed to be taken in tax enforcement and collection measures to secure greater compliance?**
