I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Nandcoomar Bodha, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence & Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service & Administrative Reforms and Minister of Rodrigues & Outer Islands at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 05 December 2006 at 11.30 a.m.**

*To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence & Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service and Administrative Reforms and Minister of Rodrigues & Outer Islands:-*

**Whether, in relation to the law and order situation, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to where matters stand in regard to -**

- (a) the case of jockey François Heroldt arrested by the MCIT on 25 November 2006;
- (b) the arrest of Sada Curpen with SUBUTEX in Trou aux Biches on 10 August 2006;
- (c) the inquiry into the case of illegal betting against bookmaker Joomun which started in July 2006;
- (d) the arrest of Manan Fakoo sentenced to prison in June 2005; and
- (e) the Police inquiry in the transfer of the sum of Rs 150m by Hemant Bangaleea on 24 November 2006 in connection with a transaction of State land?
