**Whether, in regard to the Declaration of Assets Act, he will state if the –**

- (a) proposed amendment to provide for Members of the National Assembly to make declarations of assets and liabilities through the Clerk and Mr Speaker and for same to be made public, as referred to in the House on 31 May 2011, has been prepared; and**
- (b) draft of a new Declaration of Assets Bill in replacement of the existing Act and the Report containing proposals aimed at reinforcing our anti-corruption framework, submitted by the Parliamentary Committee for the monitoring of the Independent Commission Against Corruption, will be circulated?**
