## **PRIVATE NOTICE QUESTION**

The Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Georges Pierre Lesjongard, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Minister of Commerce and Consumer Protection, at the sitting to be held today **Tuesday 24 March 2026 at 11.30 a.m.** -

*To ask the Honourable Minister of Commerce and Consumer Protection-*

**Whether, in regard to the ongoing conflict in the Middle East, he will-**

- (a) state if any study has been carried out on the impact thereof on the purchasing power of the citizens of Mauritius and, if so, indicate the findings thereof and the measures his Ministry proposes to take in relation thereto; and**
- (b) for the benefit of the House, obtain from the State Trading Corporation, information as to the-**
  - (i) current state of the Price Stabilization Account of Mogas and Gas Oil and the projected expenditure thereof over the next six months; and**
  - (ii) amount disbursed from the Price Stabilisation Fund to date, indicating how same has been disbursed and how the remaining balance will be spent over the next three months?**
