The Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Georges Pierre Lesjongard, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands, at the sitting to be held today **Tuesday 07 April 2026 at 11.30 a.m.** -

*To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands -*

**Whether, in regard to the Inter-Ministerial Committee set up to look into the economic and social impact of the present conflict in the Middle East, he will state -**

- (a) the number of times the said Committee met to date, indicating the outcome thereof;
- (b) whether any report and/or findings have been submitted in relation thereto and, if so, whether consideration will be given to table copy thereof; and
- (c) the measures being contemplated to address the economic situation arising therefrom, indicating the estimated amount of Value Added Tax and excise duties to be collected on petroleum products during this financial year and whether consideration will be given for the reduction of taxes and excise duties on the said products?
