The Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Georges Pierre Lesjongard, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands, at the sitting to be held today **Tuesday 19 May 2026 at 11.30 a.m. –**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands –

Whether, in regard to the posts of Refuse Collector and General Worker, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Local Government Service Commission (LGSC), information as to the number of employees recruited in each local authority in the 2026 recruitment exercise, indicating the –

- (a) number of rejected applications in the 2026 recruitment exercise;**
- (b) number of the 2026 recruits –**
 - (i) whose services from the 2024 recruitment exercise were terminated in January/February 2026; and**
 - (ii) who are subject to police cases and do not possess a clean Certificate of Character; and**
- (c) findings of the enquiry conducted, if any, following accusations of discrimination against the former chairperson of the LGSC, Dr S. M., in relation thereto?**
