The Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Georges Pierre Lesjongard, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands, at the sitting to be held today **Tuesday 02 June 2026 at 11.30 a.m.** –

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands –

Whether, in regard to synthetic drugs, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain information as to, since January 2025 to date-

- (a) from the Commissioner of Police, the-**
 - (i) number of road traffic accidents involving drivers tested to be under the influence thereof and the number of casualties resulting therefrom; and**
 - (ii) actions taken to curb the proliferation thereof;**
- (b) whether the National Agency for Drug Control has carried out a study on the use thereof and, if so, indicate the estimated number of users thereof identified and the actions taken/being envisaged to tackle the proliferation thereof; and**
- (c) the types of synthetic drugs, including newly synthetic drugs analysed by the Forensic Science Laboratory?**
