PRIVATE NOTICE QUESTION

The Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Georges Pierre Lesjongard, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Minister of Commerce and Consumer Protection, at the sitting to be held today **Tuesday 07 July 2026 at 11.30 a.m.** –

To ask the Honourable Minister of Commerce and Consumer Protection–

Whether, in regard to consumer protection, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain information as to –

- (a) whether any study was carried out prior to the introduction of the Price Stabilisation Fund, indicating the impact thereof as at June 2026, giving a breakdown of the expenditure of Rs 1.4 billion incurred thereunder, further indicating the names of the importers or operators having benefitted therefrom and amount disbursed in each case;**
- (b) whether he will table the list of products to be impacted by the excise duty levied on sugar content of sugar sweetened products with effect from 20th June 2026 and on PET bottle, respectively; and**
- (c) the number of inspections carried out and contraventions booked by the Consumer Affairs Unit in relation thereto, since the presentation of the Budget Speech 2026-2027 to date?**
