The Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Georges Pierre Lesjongard, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands, at the sitting to be held today **Tuesday 04 August 2026 at 11.30 a.m. –**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands –

Whether, in regard to the search carried out on 31 July 2026 at the residence of Mr G. G. and Hon. V. L. G., he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain information from the –

- (a) Commissioner of Police, as to the names of the persons arrested and interviewed and articles and vehicle seized, if any, indicating the names of the registered owners thereof and whether incriminating articles were found in the vehicle seized and whether Mr G. G. and Hon. V. L. G. were interviewed under caution and provisionally charged and, if not, why not;**
- (b) Financial Crimes Commission, whether an inquiry has been initiated into suspected money laundering offences predicated by drug dealing activities against Mr G. G. and Hon. V. L. G. and, if not, why not; and**
- (c) Attorney-General's Office, whether a request for mutual legal assistance has been made to Reunion Island and, if so, indicate the outcome thereof?**
