Whether, in regard to cases of flooding along Old Moka Road, Quatre Bornes since January 2022 to date causing the collapse of part of the wall of the St Jean Cemetery on Wednesday 08 November 2023 and the subsequent damages caused to a number of tombs as well as to houses situated along Colville Avenue and the adjoining roads, he will state the action undertaken, if any, indicating if contingency plans have been drawn up for the evacuation of residents thereat in case of need?
