I have to inform you that Dr the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Arvin Boolell, G.O.S.K., MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues, Outer Islands and Territorial Integrity, at the sitting to be held today **Tuesday 25 June 2024 at 11.30 a.m.** –

To ask the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues, Outer Islands and Territorial Integrity –

Whether, in regard to the proposed setting up of a graphite refinery by NextSource CSPG (Mauritius) Ltd., in the Port Area, he will state –

- (a) **the reasons as to why the said project was not entertained at Jin Fei and the date thereof;**
- (b) **if there is any unfavourable report against the project in the Port Area;**
- (c) **the security risks, if any, to the neighbouring population, the factories and the Ramsar site; and**
- (d) **the total estimated cost of the project and expected annual return thereof?**
