PRIVATE NOTICE QUESTION

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Dr Arvin Boolell, G.O.S.K., MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues, Outer Islands and Territorial Integrity, at the sitting to be held today Friday 02 August 2024 at 4.00 p.m. –

To ask the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues, Outer Islands and Territorial Integrity –

Whether, in regard to the inquiries initiated into the death of Mr S. K. in October 2020, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to if —

- (a) any suspects have been -
 - (i) arrested and, if so, when; and
 - (ii) interrogated under warning and, if so, when;
- (b) any enquiry with regard to the way in which the autopsy was performed has been completed; and
- (c) the Police has retrieved any safe city images in relation to the deceased's last trip to La Louise and how he reached Telfair?
