I wish to reiterate that pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 27, admissibility of Questions rests with the Speaker. Further, in accordance with the provisions of Standing Order 21(4), when a question has been refused, the matter must be taken by the

Hon. Member privately with the Speaker. The responsibility of seeking clarifications as to the reasons why a parliamentary question has been disallowed by the Speaker rests with the Hon. Member concerned and not the Speaker or the Clerk.
