PRIVATE NOTICE QUESTION

The Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Georges Pierre Lesjongard, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Minister of Land Transport at the sitting to be held today **Monday 30 June 2025 at 2.00 p.m.** –

To ask the Honourable Minister of Land Transport -

Whether, in regard to the measures announced in the Budget 2025/2026 with a view to reducing the number of vehicles on our roads, he will –

- (a) state if a prior study was carried out in relation thereto and, if so, indicate the outcome thereof and whether consultations were carried out with the stakeholders; and
- (b) for the benefit of the House, obtain information as to the -
 - (i) estimated quantum of additional revenue to be generated over the period July 2025 to June 2026 in terms of revised Excise Duty and Customs Duty, Registration Duty and Road Motor Vehicle Licence; and
 - (ii) number of vehicles sold in June 2025?
