PRIVATE NOTICE QUESTION

The Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Georges Pierre Lesjongard, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Minister of Industry, SME and Cooperatives, at the sitting to be held today **Friday 04 July 2025 at 3.00 p.m.** –

To ask the Honourable Minister of Industry, SME and Cooperatives -

Whether, in regard to the compulsory requirement for businesses to register for Value Added Tax purposes upon making a turnover of taxable supplies exceeding Rs 3 million, he will state –

- (a) if an analysis of the impact thereof on the Small and Medium Enterprises (SME) sector has been carried out;
- (b) the estimated revenue to be generated therefrom;
- (c) the number and types of businesses concerned therewith; and
- (d) whether Government held consultations and meetings with the stakeholders of the SME sector prior and after the presentation of the Budget Speech 2025-2026?
