Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications at the sitting to be held today, **Monday 14 November 2011 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications –

Whether, in regard to late Mr A. K. R. who passed away on 30 July 2011, whilst in Police custody, at the Rivière du Rempart Police Station, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to if –

- (a) an inquiry has been carried out into the circumstances under which his dead body was found lying on the floor of his cell when he is reported to have hanged himself to the iron bar of the cell door and, if so, the outcome thereof;**
- (b) his two sons were involved in the post-mortem examination of his body at different times and, if so, how; and**
- (c) members of the Very Important Person Security Unit were present at the Rivière du Rempart Police Station, on or about 30 July 2011?**
