Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Vice-Prime Minister, Minister of Finance and Economic Development at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 17 May 2011 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Honourable Vice-Prime Minister, Minister of Finance and Economic Development –

Whether, in regard to the Director of the Valuation and Real Estate and Consultancy Services, he will state if he –

- (a) is allowed to undertake private valuations or be a partner in private companies offering valuation services and, if so, the private valuations undertaken by him, indicating whether a record of the sums paid to him by private parties or government entities is kept;**
- (b) has kept an updated valuation database as required by law; and**
- (c) has been suspended from duty, following his arrest by the Independent Commission Against Corruption?**
