I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Béranger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Minister of Public Infrastructure, National Development Unit, Land Transport and Shipping at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 19 July 2011 at 11.30 a.m.**

*To ask the Honourable Minister of Public Infrastructure, National Development Unit, Land Transport and Shipping –*

**Whether, in regard to the National Transport Corporation, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Corporation, information as to the –**

- (a) number of –**
  - (i) employees;**
  - (ii) buses, indicating the (i) maintenance costs (ii) average number thereof remaining idle and (iii) number of accidents in which they are involved, indicating the nature thereof,**  
**since 2005 to-date, on a yearly basis;**
- (b) present number of buses over 10 and 16 years;**
- (c) age of the 24 buses dedicated to school service;**
- (d) tender procedure followed for the acquisition of buses and of spare parts; and**
- (e) profit or loss for the first quarter of 2011 and the total debt as at to-date?**
