I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 22 March 2011 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications –

Whether, in regard to the acquisition of the Med Point Clinic by the State, he will –

- (a) state if he agrees to the setting up of a Select Committee to establish all the facts, in particular –**
 - (i) if all the prescribed procedures have been followed;**
 - (ii) the cost of rehabilitation and other works to be carried out; and**
 - (iii) the date on which the Central Procurement Board awarded the tender;**
- (b) for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to if, regarding the recent reported case of arson at Belle Terre, the police inquiry has revealed any link thereto?**
