I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 28 June 2011 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications –

Whether, in regard to the Resolution which was recently adopted by the United Nations Human Rights Council, with the support of Mauritius, affirming for the first time the rights of the homosexuals and directing the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights to produce a report on the laws and practices that discriminate against the homosexuals in various countries, including Mauritius, by December 2011, he will state if Government proposes to bring amendments to the domestic laws which discriminate against the homosexuals to be in line thereto and, if so, indicate the laws to be amended?
