**Private Notice Question**

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Minister of Fisheries and Rodrigues at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 05 July 2011 at 11.30 a.m.**

*To ask the Honourable Minister of Fisheries and Rodrigues –*

**Whether, in regard to fisheries, he will state –**

- (a) if the Consultative Committee of the Ministry and *Syndicat des Pêcheurs* is holding its meetings;**
- (b) if the Master Plan has been finalised;**
- (c) if Government proposes to forbid net fishing and take additional measures to prevent illegal fishing in Mauritius and in Rodrigues;**
- (d) if security equipment is provided to fishermen;**
- (e) where matters stand concerning the Fish Auction Market and projects under the Fishermen Investment Trust; and**
- (f) the yearly catch, since 2005 to-date –**
  - (i) in-lagoon;**
  - (ii) off-lagoon;**
  - (iii) from bank fisheries;**
  - (iv) from aquaculture; and**
  - (v) of tuna in our Exclusive Economic Zone?**
