**Whether, in regard to Rodrigues, he will state if he has been informed by the Commissioner of Police of dissatisfaction and tensions thereat as a result of the –**

- (a) Rodrigues Regional Assembly not having been consulted for the proposed setting up of a Port Mathurin Town Council and of Village Committees thereat;**
- (b) appointment of a Parliamentary Private Secretary therefor; and**
- (c) decision to introduce the Creole language in the education sector thereat, as from January 2012?**
