To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands -

Whether, in regard to the Commission of Experts on Pension Reform, he will state whether -

- (a) the appointment process of the experts thereof underwent due diligence in adherence to established standards of independence, transparency and governance;**
- (b) any appointee thereof held or currently holds a direct or indirect financial, professional or advisory stake in any financial institution, specifically pension, insurance, investment or actuarial firm; and**
- (c) each member thereof was required to submit a declaration of interests prior to assuming office and, if so, whether consideration will be given for the tabling thereof?**
