**Private Notice Question**

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Minister of Industry and Commerce at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 15 June 2010 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Honourable Minister of Industry and Commerce:-

**Whether, in regard to the State Trading Corporation, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Corporation, information as to –**

- (a) the details of the present price structure for diesel and Mogas, indicating the (i) hedging losses incurred as at to-date and (ii) sums paid to filling stations and petroleum companies on the occasion of the last general election;**
- (b) whether tenders for petroleum products will be called for;**
- (c) the commodities and respective quantities thereof imported by the STCM Limited; and**
- (d) the losses incurred, if any, on the recent re-tendering exercise for the supply of ration rice?**
