I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 06 July 2010 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications:-

Whether, in regard to the MCB/NPF affair and the judgement of the Supreme Court delivered in relation thereto last Wednesday, he will

- (a) for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to the details of criminal cases still pending before our courts;**
- (b) table copy of the judgement of the United Kingdom Court which discharged Mr Teeren Appassamy from extradition proceedings; and**
- (c) say whether he will agree to the setting up of a Select Committee of the House to inquire into the way the Teeren Appassamy and Robert Lesage cases have been handled by the Authorities concerned?**
