**Private Notice Question**

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK., MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence and Home Affairs at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 30 March 2010 at 11.30 a.m.**

*To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence and Home Affairs –*

**Whether, in regard to law and order and the recent cases of criminal acts involving violence and of sexual aggression, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to –**

- (a) where matters stand in regard to the –
  - (i) riots at Ste Croix on Saturday 13 March and Triolet on Sunday 14 March 2010;
  - (ii) clashes between groups of bouncers in possession of illegal weapons;
  - (iii) aggressions against Police and Prison Officers;
  - (iv) Denis Fine case; and
  - (v) sexual assault on a 8-year-old child at Rose Hill on 15 March 2010?
- (b) measures that are being taken for a better protection of the population;
