**Private Notice Question**

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Finance and Economic Development at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 10 June 2008 at 11.30 a.m.**

*To ask Dr the Honourable Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Finance and Economic Development:-*

**Whether, in regard to the Tianli Project, he will –**

- (a) table copy of the Framework Agreement, including the two Schedules, between Tianli and the Government of Mauritius, represented by himself;**
- (b) state the cost to Government in terms of road infrastructure and provision for electricity, water and telephone facilities;**
- (c) list the concessions granted to Tianli; and**
- (d) state whether only companies incorporated in China will be authorized to operate in the economic and trade zone thereof and, if so, the reasons therefor?**
