To ask Dr the Honourable Minister Prime Minister, Minister of Defence & Home Affairs, Minister of Civil Service & Administrative Reforms and Minister of Rodrigues & Outer Islands:-

Whether, in regard to the present policy in respect of foreigners, relating to their entry into Mauritius, the grant of residence permit and the authorisation to acquire property, he will state -

- (a) the present number of holders of (i) residence permit and (ii) certificate of acquisition of property;**
- (b) the changes which are envisaged in the light of the proposals contained in the Budget Speech 2006-2007; and**
- (c) the measures to be taken for the implementation of the new policy?**
