I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Vice-Prime Minister, Minister of Public Infrastructure, National Development Unit, Land Transport and Shipping at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 01 April 2014 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask the Honourable Vice-Prime Minister, Ministry of Public Infrastructure, National Development Unit, Land Transport and Shipping –

Whether, in regard to the Ring Road Project, he will –

- (a) for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Road Development Authority, information as to –**
 - (i) the estimated cost of Phase I thereof, indicating –**
 - A. how was the consultant therefor chosen, indicating if his report on the damages caused thereto will be made public;**
 - B. who carried out the soil tests therefor;**
 - C. how was the contractor therefor chosen;**
 - D. how will the repairs to the road and the retaining wall be financed;**
 - E. what supervision was exercised by the Authority;**
 - F. what measures are being taken to protect the inhabitants living in the vicinity thereof; and**
 - (ii) when will Phase II thereof start; and**
- (b) state if there has been land speculation in relation thereto?**
