Private Notice Question

I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, G.C.S.K., MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Minister of Health and Quality at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 30 June 2009 at 11.30 a.m.**

To ask Dr the Honourable Minister of Health and Quality of Life –

Whether, in regard to the swine influenza (A(H₁N₁)), he will state -

- (a) if a first case has been confirmed in Mauritius;**
- (b) the testing facilities available locally;**
- (c) the screening done of incoming passengers onboard planes and at disembarkment;**
- (d) if Government has ordered vaccines which have recently started being produced;**
- (e) the special arrangements made *vis-à-vis* the high-risk countries; and**
- (f) the measures Government proposes to take for those proceeding on the forthcoming Hajj pilgrimage?**
