I have to inform you that the Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Paul Raymond Bérenger, GCSK, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Minister of Business, Enterprise, Commerce and Consumer Protection at the sitting to be held today, **Tuesday 14 June 2011 at 11.30 a.m.**

*To ask the Honourable Minister of Business, Enterprise, Commerce and Consumer Protection –*

**Whether, in regard to the State Trading Corporation, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Corporation, information as to –**

- (a) in relation to petroleum products –**
  - (i) if the hedging surcharge will be removed and, if so, when;**
  - (ii) the losses due to contamination and sediment content therein, since 2005 to-date;**
  - (iii) if a report has been received, following the Red Eagle's first trip; and**
  - (iv) where matters stand concerning the setting up of a refinery therefor and increasing the storage capacity thereof;**
- (b) the actions taken, if any, following the report submitted by Insight Forensics Services Ltd.; and**
- (c) if the Corporation is being restructured?**
