A BILL

To amend the President's Emoluments and Pension Act

ENACTED by the Parliament of Mauritius, as follows –

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the President's Emoluments and Pension (Amendment) Act 2003.

2. Interpretation

In this Act –

“principal Act” means the President's Emoluments and Pension Act.

3. Section 3 of the principal Act repealed and replaced.

Section 3 of the principal Act is repealed and replaced by the following section –

3. Emoluments of the President and the Vice-President

(1) There shall be paid to the President by way of emoluments -

- (a) with effect from 1 July 2003, an annual salary of 1,406,148 rupees;
- (b) with effect from 1 July 2004, an annual salary of 1,506,000 rupees; and
- (c) an annual duty allowance of 250,800 rupees.

(2) There shall be paid to the Vice-President by way of emoluments -

- (a) with effect from 1 July 2003, an annual salary of 1,010,148 rupees;
- (b) with effect from 1 July 2004, an annual salary of 1,080,000 rupees; and
- (c) an annual duty allowance of 180,000 rupees.

- (3) The emoluments payable under subsections (1) and (2) shall be paid by equal monthly instalments at the end of each month.

4. Commencement

This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 July 2003.
