A BILL

To amend the Constitution

ENACTED by the Parliament of Mauritius, as follows –

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Amendment) Act 2024.

2. Section 41 of Constitution amended

Section 41 of the Constitution is amended –

- (a) in subsection (1), by inserting, after the words “such members” and “such elections”, the words “, and matters relating to political financing,” and “, and to political financing,”, respectively;
 - (b) in subsection (2), by inserting, after the words “and elections”, the words “, and to political financing,”;
 - (c) in subsection (3), by inserting, after the words “such members”, the words “, or to political financing,”.
