A BILL

To amend the State Lands Act

ENACTED by the Parliament of Mauritius, as follows –

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the State Lands (Amendment) Act 2024.

2. Interpretation

In this Act –

“principal Act” means the State Lands Act.

3. Section 5 of principal Act amended

Section 5 of the principal Act is amended, in subsection (5), by inserting, after the words “(10 perches)”, the words “or not exceeding such larger extent as may be prescribed”.
