PRIVATE NOTICE QUESTION

The Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Georges Pierre Lesjongard, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to the Honourable Minister of Energy and Public Utilities, at the sitting to be held today **Tuesday 04 March 2025 at 11.30 a.m.** –

To ask the Honourable Minister of Energy and Public Utilities –

Whether, in regard to the prevailing dry season, he will –

- (a) **for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Central Water Authority, information as to the –**
- (i) **current volume and percentage of water storage in each reservoir;**
 - (ii) **actual percentage of ground water in each of the six supply zones, indicating in each case the water production and water deficit on a daily basis; and**
 - (iii) **number of new boreholes drilled since December 2024 to date, indicating the additional volume of water harnessed therefrom; and**
- (b) **state the number of families who have benefitted from the water tank and rain water harvesting grant schemes since December 2024 to date?**
