## PRIVATE NOTICE QUESTION

The Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Georges Pierre Lesjongard, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands, at the sitting to be held today **Tuesday 07 October 2025 at 11.30 a.m.** –

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands –

Whether, in regard to Mr R.S., former Governor and Mr G.S., former second Deputy Governor of the Bank of Mauritius (BoM), he will -

- (a) state the reasons -
  - (i) for the resignation thereof, indicating the actions, if any, taken at the level of his Office to reinstate confidence in the BoM and the financial sector; and
  - (ii) why he asked Mr R.S. to resign as Chairperson of the Financial Services Commission; and
- (b) for the benefit of the House, obtain information as to the -
  - (i) compensation paid thereto; and
  - (ii) total cost of missions undertaken and *per diem* allowances paid thereto?
