PRIVATE NOTICE QUESTION

The Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Georges Pierre Lesjongard, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands, at the sitting to be held today **Friday 10 October 2025 at 3.00 p.m.** –

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands –

Whether, in regard to assaults, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police, information as to the number of reported cases thereof since January 2025 to date, indicating the number of –

- (a) fatal ones;
- (b) arrests effected in connection therewith, further indicating if suspects are habitual criminals and/or suspected of having committed same whilst on bail in respect of other offences or whilst on release on parole;
- (c) such assaults perpetrated on Police Officers in the line of duty; and
- (d) unresolved cases?
