The Honourable Leader of the Opposition, Mr Georges Pierre Lesjongard, MP, has given notice of the following Private Notice Question which he proposes to put to Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands, at the sitting to be held today **Tuesday 09 December 2025 at 11.30 a.m.** –

To ask Dr the Honourable Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister of Finance, Minister for Rodrigues and Outer Islands –

Whether, in regard to alleged breaches of the provisions governing election expenses incurred in relation to the National Assembly Elections 2024 under the Representation of the Peoples Act, he will, for the benefit of the House, obtain from the Commissioner of Police and the Electoral Commissioner, information as to whether any complaint has been reported in relation thereto, indicating in each case where matters stand, further indicating the –

- (a) date(s) thereof and at which police stations;
- (b) constituencies and elected representatives concerned therewith; and
- (c) names of the persons interrogated by the Police as at date?
