JOIN THE FIFTH EDITION OF THE NATIONAL YOUTH PARLIAMENT

The Mauritius National Assembly is hosting the fifth edition of the National Youth Parliament which aims at providing a platform for young persons to –

- (i) discuss issues of national and international importance in a parliamentary set up;
- (ii) develop an interest and understanding of parliamentary history, etiquette and procedure; and
- (iii) develop their public speaking, presentation, leadership and decision-making skills, as well as enhance their ability to network with fellow citizens for the achievement of common goals.

Applications are hereby invited from eligible candidates who wish to be considered for participation in the National Youth Parliament which will be held on **Thursday 13** and **Friday 14 August 2026** in the Chamber, Mauritius National Assembly.

A. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Applicants must be -
 - (i) a Mauritian Citizen;
 - (ii) aged between 14 and 23 years as at closing date; and
 - (iii) proficient in English and French.
2. **Applications from participants of former editions of the National Youth Parliament will NOT be considered.**
